The Mind of God is limitless in Its capacity for creative expression. That Mind expresses by means of all of us. Our ability to conceptualize is also without limit.

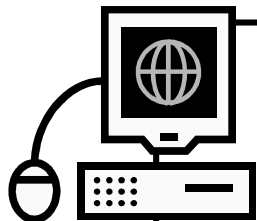
We can do or be or have whatever we can conceive possible for ourselves. The ability to demonstrate registers at the level of our consciousness.

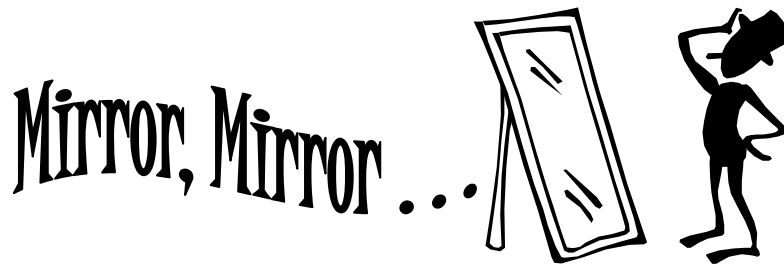
